- The names of foals born in 2018 begin with the letter N
- Once we receive the completed birth report, we will mail you an Invoice for registration and (if applicable) chip fees for the foal within 14 days.
- Every holder is legally obligated to have his horse identified with a transponder and a passport within six months of its birth.
- Breeders of foals stabled abroad must send the KWPN a drawing of their foal, performed by a veterinarian along with clear color photos of the mare and foal. Hair samples (mane strands with roots) from the mare and foal are also required for DNA testing. These samples must be collected by a veterinarian. The studbook office reports foal birth to the Passport Consultant, who performs drawings and injects chip on-site when the horse is stabled in the Netherlands.
- We will issue proof of registration and an equine passport upon processing the veterinary drawing, chip, and DNA testing (if required).
