**Exterior:**

Everglow Gold is a strongly modelled, uphill-built stallion with much stallion expression. He has strong connections and stands well in the rectangular model. The neck is good in length, strongly muscled, and arched upward. The withers and shoulder are strongly developed. The back and loins are well muscled and well connected. The croup is well placed and long. The foreleg is correctly aligned. The hindleg is slightly straight. The hooves are well developed and of good quality. The heels are appropriately developed.

**Pedigree:**

Premium stallion Everglow Gold is, on the dam's side, a grandson of the well-known Grand Prix mare Weihegold OLD, with whom Isabell Werth was highly successful. They surpassed 90% multiple times, won team gold and individual silver at the Rio de Janeiro Olympic Games, double gold at the European Championships in Gothenburg, and achieved more than 50 international victories in total. Weihegold has also proven to be exceptional in breeding, producing offspring such as Total Hope OLD (s.Totilas), who was successful at the Paris Olympics and the European Championships in Riesenbeck and Crozet under Isabel Freese, and Special Gold PCH (s.San Amour I), classified Intermediaire II under Katharina Hemmer. Weihegold herself is a half-sister to the Grand Prix horses Total Recall (s.Totilas) ridden by Jemma Heran and Tripple X (s.Totilas) ridden by Hope Cooper. More Grand Prix genes have been added to this pedigree via sire Escolar, who competed successfully at the highest level with Hubertus Schmidt. He is making a name for himself as a sire with more than ten Grand Prix offspring and is influential through sons such as Escamillo, who was a medal winner at the World Championships for Young Dressage Horses.

**Performance report:**

Everglow Gold is an impressive stallion with power and strength. He is somewhat dominant but allowed himself to be increasingly well managed throughout the test. The walk is good in four-beat rhythm, powerful, marching, and shows scope. The foreleg could reach further forward. The trot has much power, the hindleg shows strength and force, and this is well transmitted through the topline. The foreleg shows much knee action. The canter has much power and jump, the overall picture is uphill with a carrying hindleg and an expressive foreleg. Everglow Gold gained suppleness and relaxation during the performance test; he has much ability to collect and extend, shows uphill tendency and self-carriage. The contact is consistent and stable; occasionally the stallion grinds his teeth slightly.

Honest, reliable stallion, easy to handle and quiet in the stable.

**Veterinary report:**

No abnormalities detected.

Expected fertility class: good.

**Breeding/mating advice:**

Everglow Gold can add strength, power, dressage genes, and improve the model in dressage horse breeding.

**Dam report:**

Weihe's Hope is a sufficiently developed mare who stands well in the rectangular model. The poll is good in length with a light poll-neck connection. The neck is good in length, good in shape and musculature. The withers are somewhat low and extend sufficiently into the back. The shoulder is sufficiently long and slightly steep in placement. The back is well muscled and the loins are strongly connected. The croup is slightly straight in its placement and sufficiently long. The foreleg is correct from the side and correct from the front. The hindleg is correctly aligned. The front pasterns are slightly soft; the hind pasterns are well aligned. The hooves are sufficiently developed with slightly low heels. The foundation is appropriately developed and hard in quality. The walk is active and sufficiently roomy. The trot is light-footed and elegant; the hindleg is placed well under the body, and the mare departs with a good posture. The trot shows sufficient use of the body. The canter has impulsion and sufficient suppleness; again the good hindleg use and good balance stand out.

**Exterior:**

Sensation Gold is a well-developed stallion who stands very well in the rectangular model. The neck is good in length, well muscled, and arched upward. The shoulder is good in length and placement. The withers are well developed and extend noticeably far into the back, which is well muscled. The loins are well muscled and well connected. The croup is correctly placed but could be slightly longer. The foreleg shows a slightly hollow stance from the side and is correct from the front. The hindleg is slightly straight. The hooves are broad and of good quality; the heels are slightly uneven. The foundation could express a bit more quality.

**Pedigree:**

Premium stallion Sensation Gold is bred out of the national Grand Prix mare Imagine, ridden by Jeroen van Eck. As a three-year-old, this NMK mare already demonstrated her dressage talent by passing the mare test with 85.5 points, including 9s for canter and posture & balance. Imagine already produced two elite mares, including the well-tested My Lady (s.Glock's Toto Jr.) with 79 points, who competes in Z2 dressage. Granddam T-Michaella produced the ZZ-Zwaar horses Amazing (s.Tango) and Exception (s.Tango), and is herself a half-sister to the Small Tour horses Bromelia (by Gribaldi) ridden internationally by Maria Jimena Escandon, Hamalia (s.Bordeaux), and Willia (s.Gribaldi). The international Small Tour horse Berlioz (s.Vivaldi) also descends from this direct damline. Sire Ferguson was rising strongly in sport and breeding before a misstep proved fatal, and he died at only twelve years old. His Grand Prix debut was imminent, and he already produced several standout offspring, such as Kyton, Lightning Star, My Precious, Lord Platinum, and First Lewis.

**Performance report:**

Sensation Gold is a friendly and sympathetic stallion. He is fresh but even-tempered and very focused on the rider. The walk is in four-beat, with much scope, he is nicely relaxed and shows a swinging motion. The trot is elastic with swing and scope. The hindleg could be more decisive by nature, but he allows himself to be well worked. The foreleg has good shoulder freedom. The canter is balanced and expressive with scope; he shows jump and presents an uphill silhouette. The stallion has much ability to collect and transition and allows himself to be worked exceptionally well. Sensation Gold performed very consistently throughout the test.

**Stable behaviour:**

Honest, reliable stallion, easy to handle and quiet in the stable.

**Veterinary report:**

The stallion was treated with gastric medication during the performance test.



#### **Dam report:**

Imagine is a refined mare with much expression and a dressage-type appearance. The mare stands sufficiently in the rectangular model and has an uphill body direction. The head is expressive. The poll is good in length with a light poll-neck connection. The neck is beautifully shaped, arched upward, good in length and musculature. The withers are well developed and sufficiently long. The back is good in length and sufficiently muscled; the loins are sufficiently connected. The croup is good in placement, musculature, and length. The foreleg is correctly aligned from the front and the side. The hindleg is correctly aligned. The pasterns front and back are normal in length and well aligned. The hooves are well developed, good in shape, with sufficiently high heels. The foundation is appropriate in size, good in quality, and expresses hardness. The walk is active, pure in rhythm, sufficiently roomy, with a hindleg that steps resolutely under. The trot is light-footed with an active hindleg that is placed under with power and impulsion; the mare forms a beautiful silhouette. The canter is very balanced with good leg technique; the mare clearly canters uphill with strong use of the hindleg and much self-carriage.

**Exterior:**

Sondale is a stallion with good proportions in his body; he stands well in the rectangular model. The neck is well shaped and muscled, with a light throatlatch. The shoulder is long and sloping, and the withers extend well into the back. The back and loins are well muscled and well connected. The croup is slightly straight and good in length.

The foreleg is correctly aligned. The hindleg is slightly straight. The hooves are well shaped and of good quality with appropriately developed heels.

**Pedigree:**

Sire Glamourdale was champion as a three-year-old at the KWPN Stallion Show, won his first world title at seven, and took double gold at the World Equestrian Games in Herning. At the Paris Olympic Games, he won two bronze medals. He is also influential in breeding, with several progeny already competing at the highest level, such as Kuvasz RS2 N.O.P., Kashmir, and Karlody MB. Sondale is bred out of a full sister to the Intermediaire II horse Coco, ridden by Diane Rose. Through damsire Vivaldi, a proven supplier of Grand Prix horses such as Dream Boy, Desperado, Expression, and Cennin, additional quality enters the pedigree. In the third generation, via movement sire Houston, this Dutch damline traces back to the half-blood mare Eva, who also stands at the foundation of the international Grand Prix horses Ferero (s.Ferro) ridden by Chantal Wigan and Ferrari (s.Apache) ridden by Jeanine Nekeman.

**Performance report:**

Sondale is a balanced and sympathetic stallion. He has a willingness to work and is well focused on the rider. The walk is in good four-beat rhythm with use of the body and much scope. The trot shows balance and leg technique; the hindleg could become stronger, but steps under sufficiently. The canter has balance and scope; the hindleg carries, and a good silhouette develops. Sondale uses his body well and shows ability to collect and extend. He gives the rider a good feeling and developed positively in self-carriage during the performance test.

Honest, reliable stallion, easy to handle and quiet in the stable.

**Veterinary report:**

She stands sufficiently in the rectangular model.

The head is expressive.

The poll is good in length with a slightly heavy throatlatch connection.

The neck is very good in length, vertically shaped, and well muscled.

The withers are well developed but could extend farther into the back.

The shoulder is long and sloping.

The back is sufficiently long and sufficiently muscled; the loins could connect more strongly.

The croup is well placed, sufficiently long, and sufficiently muscled.

The foreleg is correctly aligned from the front and the side.

The hindleg is correctly aligned.

The pasterns front and back are normal in length and well aligned.

The hooves are well developed, broad in shape, with slightly low heels.

The foundation is appropriate in size and good in quality.

The walk is sufficiently roomy, rhythmic, and active, though the hindleg could step more resolutely. The walk is shown with much suppleness.

**Exterior:**

Scaramouche is a strongly modelled stallion with good proportions in the body; he stands well in the rectangular model. The forehand is very well modelled; the neck rises well upward from the withers and there is a light throatlatch connection behind the jaw.

The shoulder is sloping. The withers are well developed and extend far into the back; the back itself could be slightly stronger. The loins are broad and well connected.

The croup is good in shape and placement. The foreleg is correctly aligned from the side and from the front, and the hindleg is correctly aligned. The hooves and heels are well developed.

**Pedigree:**

Sire Glock's Toto Jr. achieved multiple top-level victories and competed at the 2024 Olympic Games. This Totilas-son is strongly influential in breeding, producing offspring such as Glock's Taminiau, My Toto, Glock's Massimo, and O'Toto van de Wimphof.

Scaramouche also carries strong genetics on the dam's side. His dam Linskymorijke scored three 9s and a total of 84.5 points in the IBOP, and performed well in young horse championships. She is currently competing in the Small Tour under Marielle Spierings. Granddam Evymorijke performed at ZZ-Zwaar level and is well known as the dam of the KWPN-approved stallion Jones (s.Negro), who was registered with 83.5 points and is the full brother of Scaramouche's dam. Evymorijke also produced the ZZ-Licht horse Kartouche (s.Negro). In the fourth generation, the damline traces back to a half-sister of the well-known international Grand Prix horse Madorijke (s.Contango), previously ridden by Madeleine Witte-Vrees and Rien van der Schaft.

**Performance report:**

Scaramouche is a stallion with presence. He is alert and responsive to the rider's aids. The walk is in four-beat, diligent from the hindleg, with use of the body and good scope. The trot is rhythmic with a diligent hindleg that steps well under and carries; he shows cadence and is light-footed. The canter is balanced and rhythmic, he shows suppleness and scope, though the hindleg could show slightly more mechanical action. Scaramouche forms a beautiful silhouette and demonstrates moments of ability to take weight behind. Throughout the test, the stallion presented a stable and well-balanced overall picture.

**Exterior:**

Spectre is a generously developed stallion who stands well in the rectangular model. The neck emerges slightly deep from the chest, is sufficient in length, and well muscled. The shoulder is long and well placed. The withers are well developed and extend far into the back. The back and loins are strong and well connected. The croup is well placed and long. The foreleg is correctly aligned from the side, but slightly toe-in from the front. The hindleg is correctly aligned, with the pasterns being slightly straight. The hooves are sufficiently developed and of good quality; the heels are slightly under-run.

**Pedigree:**

Under Ninja van Liere, sire Hermès achieved a series of international victories, two bronze medals at the World Championships in Herning, and a fourth place individually at the Paris Olympic Games. Spectre is his second KWPN-approved son. Spectre is bred out of the elite mare Jamaica, who competes at international Grand Prix level with Robin Bernoski. As a four-year-old, Jamaica passed the IBOP with 80 points and was the highest placed mare (fourth) in the Pavo Cup final. Jamaica has produced multiple promising offspring, including the NMK mare Swarovski, who like Spectre is by Hermès. Granddam So What produced the international Grand Prix horse Electra (s.Jazz), who placed sixth in the World Championships for seven-year-olds and later competed for years at the highest level under Lynne Maas. She also produced the Small Tour horse Havanna (s.Sir Donnerhall I). So What appears in the second generation behind the international Small Tour horse Medoc (s.Vivaldi), ridden by Brittany Fraser. She is also the full sister of the Olympic dressage horse Mythilus, with whom Courtney King competed in Hong Kong.

**Performance report:**

Spectre is a generously made stallion. He is eager to learn, alert to his surroundings, yet remains focused on the rider. The walk is in four-beat and active; he still needs to develop more use of the body and scope. The trot shows impulsion and balance; he shows leg technique but must remain more consistently relaxed. When this happens, the foreleg shows shoulder freedom and technique. The canter is impulsion, scope, and balance; at this moment, he still maintains the hindquarters somewhat high. Spectre occasionally demonstrates the ability to take weight behind, leading to more body use. He showed much willingness throughout the test and clearly made positive progress.

Honest, reliable stallion, easy to handle and quiet in the stable.
