Exterior:

Seagram is a well-developed, appealing stallion who stands well in the rectangular model with a slightly downward body direction. The head is sufficiently expressive. The poll is good in length with a light throatlatch connection. The neck is good in length and sufficiently muscled. The shoulder is good in length and well placed. The withers are well developed and good in length. The back is good in length and well muscled. The loins are well muscled and well connected. The croup is well placed and sufficiently long. The thigh is good in length. The foreleg is correct from the side and slightly French from the front. The hindleg is straight. The pasterns in front and behind are correct. The foundation is well developed and sufficiently of quality. The hooves are well shaped and of good quality. The heels are well developed.

Pedigree:

Seagram descends from the rapidly rising sire Aganix du Seigneur, who himself competed at the highest level under Jos Lansink. The stallion is establishing his name as a Grand Prix horse producer through offspring such as Ambassador Z, Agana van het Gerendal Z, Attoucha, and Maxwin Kinmar Agalux. On the dam's side we find the mare Milligram, who at eight years old is competing internationally at 1.40/1.45m level. As a three-year-old she already earned 82 points in the IBOP and later placed seventh in the NMK final. Granddam Orashi competed internationally under the name Cruisly with Jolijn Klomp and Jeroen Dubbeldam. Cruisly produced, among others, the international 1.40m horse Chapala ET Z (s.Fergar Mail), ridden by Jolijn Klomp. She is herself a half-sister to the international 1.50m horse Ulysses M2S (s.Ekstein), ridden by Rosella De Simone, as well as to the late sire President (s.Clinton), who competed internationally at 1.40m level. This direct damline also produced the internationally 1.55/1.60m-classified horses Hoover (s.Clinton), ridden by Julien Epailard, and B M All Wave (s.All Pleasure), ridden by Martin Dopazo.

Performance report:

Seagram is an uncomplicated, intelligent stallion who is very rideable. The walk and trot are pure and correct. Seagram moves functionally with good balance. He has good scope in the canter and is very light-footed, the hindleg remaining slightly straight while cantering well through the change. Seagram is very focused on the fence when jumping and uses his body very well upward over the jump. He shows good withers-shoulder technique and much use of the body, finishing the jump well behind. Seagram appears to have much athletic ability and shows carefulness. As a jumping horse, Seagram has much talent and gives the rider a good feeling over the jump.

Stable behaviour:

Honest, reliable stallion; easy to handle and quiet in the stable.

Veterinary report:

No abnormalities detected.

Breeding/mating advice:

Seagram can add jumping qualities, especially reflexes, scope, attitude, and rideability, to the jumping horse breeding population.

The neck is well formed, good in length and well muscled.

The withers are well developed and good in length.

The shoulder is correctly placed and very good in length.

The back is good in length with sufficient muscling.

The loins are well muscled and well connected.

The croup is well placed, well in length and well muscled.

The thigh is good in length.

The foreleg is correct from the front and side.

The hindleg is correct.

The front and hind pasterns are good in length and correctly aligned.

The hooves are well shaped, good in quality with well-developed heels.

The foundation is well developed and good in quality.

The walk is active, good in scope, and has sufficient suppleness.

The trot is good in scope with sufficient push-off and suppleness.

The canter is light-footed with good balance.

Exterior:

Springfield VDL is a sufficiently developed, attractive, strongly muscled stallion who stands sufficiently in the rectangular model. The head is expressive. The poll is good in length with a light throatlatch connection. The neck is well shaped, sufficiently long, and well muscled. The shoulder is good in length and well placed. The withers are well developed and sufficiently long. The back is sufficiently long and slightly weak. The loins are well muscled and sufficiently connected. The croup is sloping, sufficiently long, and well muscled. The thigh is sufficiently long. The foreleg is correct from both the side and front. The hindleg is slightly straight. The pasterns in front and behind are correct in length. The foundation is sufficiently developed and good in quality. The hooves are well developed, well shaped, and of good quality. The heels are well developed.

Pedigree:

The sire of Springfield VDL is the successful sport stallion Balou du Reventon, with whom Brian Moggre competed at the World Championships in Herning. Previously, this stallion won multiple Grands Prix with Darragh Kenny, with whom he also competed at the European Championships in Rotterdam. His oldest offspring are now breaking through at the highest level, and in this pedigree Balou du Reventon is paired with a daughter of the top mare Cella, with whom Ben Maher won team gold and individual silver at the European Championships in Herning and claimed multiple Grands Prix victories. In breeding, Cella has already made her mark with her 1.50/1.60m-performing offspring Handor van 't Roosakker, Happy Wandor van 't Roosakker, and Fabio van 't Roosakker. Springfield VDL's dam Nicella VDL left no doubt about her natural talent during the mare inspection, scoring 90 points for both reflexes and scope, and achieving a total of 85 points for free jumping. In the third generation we find the internationally 1.50m-classified mare Usha van 't Roosakker, who, besides Cella, also produced the international 1.50/1.60m horses Babbe van 't Roosakker, Emperio van 't Roosakker, Equador van 't Roosakker, and George Z.

Performance report:

Springfield VDL is a cooperative and rideable stallion who is uncomplicated during work and has a good attitude. Walk and trot show sufficient scope. The stallion allows himself to be well worked. In canter he shows sufficient scope, good balance, and is light-footed. Springfield VDL approaches the jump easily, shows good overview and judges the fence well. He is quick off the ground, with much push-off and good upward body use. He jumps with good front and hindleg technique and uses his body sufficiently to much. Springfield VDL jumps with sufficient to much scope and appears careful. He gives the rider a good feeling over the fence and has much talent as a showjumper.

Stable behaviour:

Honest, reliable stallion, easy to handle and quiet in the stable.

Springfield VDL is a carrier of the WFFS gene.

Exterior:

Salerno VDL is a well-developed stallion with a slightly classical appearance and a correct rectangular frame. The head is expressive. The neck has sufficient length with a slightly heavy poll-neck connection. The neck is well-shaped, well-muscled, and of adequate length. The shoulder is of good length and has an excellent position. The withers are well developed and of good length. The back is of good length and musculature. The loins are well muscled and sufficiently connected. The croup has a good position, adequate length, and good musculature. The thigh muscles are of good length. The foreleg is correctly aligned both from the side and from the front. The hindleg is slightly long. The pasterns, both front and hind, are correctly aligned. The foundation is well developed and more than adequate in quality. The hooves are well developed, well shaped, and of good quality. The heels are sufficiently developed.

Pedigree:

The sire of Salerno VDL is the Grand Prix stallion Carrera VDL, who in 2025 was represented by no fewer than three offspring at the European Championships in La Coruña. Carrera VDL is making his mark as a producer thanks to successful top-level offspring such as Mister Jup, Carabella vd Neyen Z, and Komboy. This damline has also produced multiple top showjumpers and traces back in the fourth generation to the Grand Prix mare Loro Piana Havinia (s.Grosso Z), who placed fifth individually at the 2002 World Equestrian Games in Jerez de la Frontera under Gianni Govoni. Granddam Gember is a half-sister to the international 1.55m Grand Prix horse Imbeer (s.Etoulon VDL), ridden by Robert Murphy, and the national 1.50m jumper Untouchable Z (s.Heartbreaker), ridden by Marilyn Little. From a half-sister of Gember comes the Olympic showjumping horse Ilex (s.Baltic VDL), ridden by McLain Ward. This direct damline has also produced the 1.55/1.60m-classified horses Kivinia (s.I'm Special de Muze), ridden by Bas Moerings, Favinia (s.Calido I), ridden by Valentina Isoardi, and Kriek (s.Kannan), ridden by Dominika Gaalova.

Performance report:

Salerno VDL is a pleasant stallion to ride with a good attitude. The stallion shows a strong willingness to work. The walk and trot offer more than sufficient scope and suppleness. In movement, Salerno VDL demonstrates good posture and balance. The canter has good scope and became lighter on the forehand during the performance test. Salerno VDL jumps with more than sufficient upward direction through the body and shows good judgement of the fence. He demonstrates good wither-shoulder technique, uses his body well, and finishes the jump well behind. Salerno VDL improved notably throughout the jumping work and appears to possess considerable scope. Under saddle, Salerno VDL gives his rider a good feeling over the jump and shows a great deal of talent as a showjumping horse.

Honest, reliable stallion, easy to handle and quiet in the stable.

Exterior:

Story of the Year PP is a well-developed, youthful, sufficiently appealing stallion who fits adequately into the rectangular model. The head is expressive. The neck has good length with a light poll-neck connection. The neck is well shaped, of good length, and sufficiently muscled. The shoulder is of more than adequate length and slightly steep in position. The withers are well developed and of good length. The back is of good length and well muscled. The loins are somewhat tightly muscled. The croup is sloping, of sufficient length, and well muscled. Story of the Year PP carries his tail to one side. The thigh muscles are of good length. The foreleg is correctly aligned both from the side and from the front. The hindleg is correctly aligned. The pasterns, front and hind, are slightly soft. The foundation is somewhat fine-boned but of good quality. The hooves are well developed, well shaped, and of good quality. The heels are well developed.

Pedigree:

As a son of the Olympic mare Valentina van 't Heike, ridden by Jos Lansink, Cavalier Russe Z boasts strong lineage. Story of the Year PP comes from the first crop of this seven-year-old, BWP-approved Casall son. On the dam's side, Story of the Year PP is a grandson of the 1.40/1.45m-classified mare Wodermie, who competed successfully under Christopher Frazer. This makes his dam Madermie PP a half-sister to the international 1.40m horse Cadermus PP (s.Contact vd Heffinck). In the third generation, the line traces back to the Burggraaf daughter Sadermie, who is a half-sister to the international showjumpers Isodermus PP (s.Kannan), classified at 1.50m level under Doron Kuipers, and the 1.45m jumper Emadermus PP (s.Cooper van de Heffinck), ridden by Pieter Clemens. In the fourth generation we find the 1.50m-classified mare Madermie, who competed under Wil Schellekens. This direct damline has also produced the international 1.50m horse VDL Legodermus PP (s.Harley VDL), who impressed under Hessel Hoekstra and is now making a name for himself from Switzerland.

Performance report:

Story of the Year PP is a cooperative stallion with a good attitude and a strong willingness to work. The walk has more than sufficient scope and suppleness. The trot has adequate scope but still lacks some power and balance. The canter shows good scope and is light-footed. Story of the Year PP jumps with a lot of push-off, very good reflexes, and appears careful. He shows good front-leg technique, makes good use of his body, and demonstrates a slightly variable hindleg technique. During the performance test, Story of the Year PP gained more relaxation in the jumping work, allowing him to finish the jump better. Story of the Year PP appears to possess considerable athletic ability and gives the rider a very good feeling. He shows much talent as a showjumping horse.

Secret Garden is a sufficiently developed, appealing, youthful stallion who fits well into the rectangular model, with a downward body direction. The head is expressive. The neck has sufficient length with a slightly heavy poll-neck connection. The neck is horizontal in shape, of good length, and more than adequately muscled. The shoulder has good length and good position. The withers are well developed and of good length. The back is of good length and well muscled. The loins have good length and are well connected. The croup is sloping, of more than sufficient length, and well muscled. The thigh muscles are of good length. The foreleg is correctly aligned from both the side and the front. The hindleg is slightly long and somewhat straight. The pasterns, front and hind, are slightly soft. The foundation is sufficiently developed and of adequate quality. The hooves are well developed, well shaped, and of good quality. The heels are well developed.

Pedigree:

Sire Cero Blue TN was approved by the KWPN as a six-year-old with the record score of 91 points and now ranks among the promising future talents of Willem Greve. At eight years old he made a successful debut at 1.45m level, and Cero Blue TN is here combined with a strong performance damline. The dam, Zanory T, made a big impression at the mare inspection and earned the ster predicate with 85 points for free jumping, including 90 for scope. This Phin Phin daughter was named champion at the Gelderland Regional Mare Championships and subsequently honoured as reserve champion at the NMK. She competed internationally at 1.30m level before being used exclusively for breeding. In combination with Tangelo van de Zuuthoeve, Zanory T already produced the international 1.60m showjumper Dizzy Lizzy, ridden by Roelof Bril, and the Grand Prix-winning stallion Key West, ridden by Jody Hall McAteer, who was approved by the KWPN as a three-year-old with 83.5 points. Zanory T also produced the 1.40/1.45m horses Entertainer (s.Calvados Z), Juicy Blue (s.Cuba Libre), and Nova Zembra (s.Tinka's Boy), and she is furthermore recorded as the granddam of the international 1.60m horse Iberico (s.Contendro I), ridden by Roelof Bril.

Performance report:

Secret Garden is a youthful, willing stallion who was easy to work with during the performance test and showed good development throughout. The walk and trot offer more than sufficient scope and suppleness. The canter is light-footed with good ground cover, though it still lacks some power and balance. Secret Garden jumps with good upward direction through the body and shows good body use. He demonstrates excellent leg technique. Secret Garden appears careful and shows athletic ability and awareness. Over the course of the test, Secret Garden gained more push-off in the jump and gave his rider a good feeling. Secret Garden shows a great deal of talent as a showjumping horse.

Stable behaviour:

Honest, reliable stallion, easy to handle and quiet in the stable.

Exterior:

Sunrise VDL is a well-developed, sufficiently appealing stallion who fits well into the rectangular model, with a slightly downward body direction. The head is expressive. The neck has sufficient length with a slightly heavy poll-neck connection. The neck is well shaped, of good length, and well muscled. The shoulder has good length and good position. The withers are well developed and of good length. The back has good length and musculature. The loins are strongly muscled. The croup is slightly sloping, more than sufficient in length, and well muscled. The thigh muscles are of good length. The foreleg is slightly hollow from the side and French in alignment when viewed from the front. The hindleg is straight. The pasterns, front and hind, are correctly aligned. The foundation is well developed and of good quality. The hooves are narrow, well shaped, and of good quality. The heels are well developed.

Pedigree:

Sunrise VDL comes from the second crop of the strikingly influential stallion Landino VDL. Under Wesley ter Harmsel, this blood-made Stakkato Gold son demonstrates his qualities at international 1.35m level, and he already sired the KWPN-approved premium stallion Raikkonen VDL. The dam, Jatendrie VDL, produced the NMK mare Ojatendrie VDL (s.Cohinoor VDL), who as a three-year-old earned 90 points for technique and scope and achieved a final score of 80/85. Granddam Fatendri VDL is a half-sister to both the World Cup showjumping horse Easton VDL (s.Indoctro), ridden by Aaron Hadlow, and the internationally 1.40m-classified KWPN stallion Impressive VDL (s.Douglas), as well as the nationally 1.40m-classified jumpers Jupilot VDL (s.Baloubet du Rouet) and Mister X VDL (s.Falaise de Muze). This is a strong branch of Holsteiner line 8763, which has produced several successful 1.50/1.60m international showjumpers, including For Cento (s.For Pleasure), Quinta 106 (s.Quidam de Revel), Cocodrillo (s.Corrado I), Quidman Denfer (s.Quidam de Revel), Quebello D (s.Quidam de Revel), Prestigious (s.Con Cento), and Quilana Denfer (s.Quidam de Revel).

Performance report:

Sunrise VDL is an easy-to-ride stallion with a good attitude. He is responsive to the aids and works well. The walk shows sufficient purity. The trot is functional with good balance. Sunrise VDL is still croup-high, which at times causes him to canter slightly on the forehand, although the canter itself is light-footed. Over the jump, the stallion is very quick and demonstrates remarkably good upward direction through the body. Sunrise VDL shows excellent technique and finishes the jump behind exceptionally well. He can shift forward very effectively on the jump and displays a great deal of athletic ability. Sunrise VDL appears very careful, gives his rider a very good feeling, and shows much to very much talent as a showjumping horse.
