Conformation: Realist van Altrido is a well-developed, sufficiently harness-typed stallion standing correctly in the rectangular model, with presence and expression. The head is expressive. The neck could be longer, and the poll-to-neck connection could be lighter. The neck is of sufficient shape and length, well-muscled, and well set on. The withers are well developed and of good length, although the transition from neck to withers could be smoother. The shoulder is of good length but could be slightly more sloping. The back has sufficient length, is well muscled, and slightly dipped. The loins are well muscled and connected. The croup is normal in position, sufficiently long, and well muscled. The thigh could be longer. The foreleg is correct in side view but slightly turned out (French) when seen from the front. The hindleg is slightly sickle-hocked and stands a fraction behind the mass. The pasterns are of good length and correctly aligned. The foundation is well developed and of good quality. The hooves are of good quality but somewhat narrow with underrun heels.

Pedigree:

The bay Realist van Altrido is a son of Innovatief and the keur preferent mare Heolanda D (s.Cizandro). Sire Innovatief is a low-related stallion with a unique pedigree. His sire Zepplin is a son of the KWPN-approved Hackney and keur stallion Plain's Liberator out of the Register A mare Bianca. This performance mare is a daughter of the American Saddlebred stallion Heiring Out. Bianca produced thirteen foals, including the successful show gelding Fontana Landzicht (Reg. B by Waterman) with 179 competition points. Bianca's ster preferent dam Nicole (s.Fabricius) produced the stallion Dylano, also by Plain's Liberator. Innovatief, ridden by Mark de Groot, won the newcomers' class in Bennekom and earned 39 competition points. In 2024, he was sold to Poland, where he now stands at stud. Dam Heolanda D produced nine foals, including the designated stallion Mondiaal (s.Icellie), now a highly successful show horse with 178 competition points. The line also produced Nevaro van Altrido (Idol out of Wolanda ster by Patijn), a designated stallion with 82 competition points. This family has also produced numerous international driving horses. Realist van Altrido is the first approved son of Innovatief.

Performance test report:

Realist van Altrido is an honest, reliable, sufficiently harness-typed stallion with a good attitude. He shows great willingness to work and is easy to handle under saddle. The walk is active, shows good impulsion, and has good scope. In harness, the stallion displays sufficient to ample front, though he could return more easily to self-carriage. He shows sufficient to ample body posture. Realist van Altrido has very good reach in the foreleg but could show more knee action. The hindleg bends sufficiently but could be placed further and more powerfully underneath the body. The stallion shows good suspension, rhythm, and balance. He possesses great enthusiasm for work and gives his driver a sufficiently positive feeling.

Stable behavior:

Honest, reliable stallion, easy to handle, and generally calm in the stable.

Veterinary report:

The right testicle was surgically removed in 2024; prior to this, the stallion had a normally developed reproductive system.

Semen evaluation:

Expected fertility class: satisfactory.

Breeding/ Mating advice:

Realist van Altrido can improve willingness to work, suspension, and rhythm and balance. Mares should preferably have a well-set foreleg and powerful hindleg use.

Dam report:

Heolanda D is a well-developed, sufficiently harness-typed mare, standing correctly in the rectangular model but could be more uphill in build.

The head is expressive.

The neck is of sufficient length, though the poll-to-neck connection could be lighter.

The neck is well shaped, well-muscled, and of good length but should be set higher.

The withers are well developed and of good length.

The shoulder is long but somewhat steep.

The back is slightly tight, of good length and musculature.

The loins are well muscled but somewhat tight in connection.

The croup is sloping, sufficiently long, and well muscled. The thigh is of good length.

The foreleg is slightly toe-in when viewed from the front and correct from the side. The hindleg is slightly sickle-hocked. The pasterns are of sufficient length and well aligned.

The hooves are normally developed and of good quality with normal heels. The foundation is well developed and of good quality.

The walk has good scope and sufficient power. In trot, the mare shows sufficient front, self-carriage, and suspension. The foreleg shows sufficient knee action and reach; the hindleg bends sufficiently and steps powerfully underneath.

Conformation:

Sjimmie HBC is a generously developed, uphill-built, harness-typed stallion standing correctly in the rectangular model, showing distinct stallion expression. The head is expressive but could be more refined in shape. The neck has sufficient length with a correct poll-to-neck connection. The neck has good length, is well-muscled, crested, and well set on. The withers are notably well developed and of good length. The shoulder is well shaped and correctly angled. The back is of good length but could show more musculature. The loins are well muscled and well connected. The croup is slightly straight but of good length. The thigh is long. The foreleg is tight in the tendons and correct when viewed from the front. The hindleg is somewhat long and stands slightly behind the body mass. The pasterns are of good length but somewhat upright in front. The foundation is substantial and of sufficient quality. The hooves are of good quality, somewhat narrow, and slightly uneven in shape, with normal heels.

Pedigree:

The bay Sjimmie HBC is from the first crop of Macho and out of the studbook mare Lirzela (s.Dylano). The stallion Macho is a son of Indiana out of Emone (ster pref by Unieko). Macho has earned 69 competition points and multiple championship titles. In 2024, he was exported to the United States by his owner. Dam Lirzela is a daughter of the highly successful champion stallion Dylano, who earned 384 competition points and is by the KWPN-approved Hackney and keur stallion Plain's Liberator. Granddam Serzela, an NMK ster mare, is by the half-Saddlebred Marvel (s.Immigrant). Great-granddam Jerzela, keur preferent, by Exponent, produced eleven offspring, six of which earned competition points. This dam line has also produced several successful international driving horses. Sjimmie HBC is the first approved son of Macho.

Performance test report:

Sjimmie HBC is an honest, reliable, harness-typed stallion with a good attitude. He shows a strong willingness to work and is very pleasant to handle under saddle. The walk is _____ active with sufficient ground cover. In harness, the stallion presents an attractive front and strong body posture. Sjimmie HBC shows high knee action and sufficient reach in the foreleg. The hindleg bends sufficiently but could step more actively underneath. He _____ shows good suspension, rhythm, and balance, and displays a great willingness to go forward. As a harness horse, he has a great deal of natural talent and gives his driver a good feeling. During the performance test, the stallion showed clear progress. _____

Stable behavior:

Honest and reliable stallion, easy to handle but generally somewhat easily distracted in the stable.

Veterinary report:

No abnormalities observed.

Semen evaluation:

Expected fertility class: Good.

Breeding/ Mating advice:

Sjimmie HBC can improve size and harness-type movement. Mares should preferably have good-quality hooves and strong hindleg use.

Dam report:

Lirzela is a well-developed, sufficiently harness-typed mare, standing adequately in the rectangular model.

The head is sufficiently expressive.

The neck could be longer with a lighter poll-to-neck connection.

The neck is of sufficient shape and length, adequately muscled, but could be set higher.

The withers are well developed and of good length.

The shoulder has sufficient length but could be more sloping.

The back is well proportioned and muscled.

The loins are well muscled and connected.

The croup is sloping, well muscled, but short.

The thigh should extend further.

The foreleg is slightly toe-in when viewed from the front and slightly camped under when viewed from the side.

The hindleg is correctly set.

The pasterns are of sufficient length and well positioned.

The hooves are slightly uneven in shape, of good quality, with slightly uneven heels.

The foundation is well developed and of good quality.

The walk could show more scope and power.

In trot, the mare has sufficient front but should show more suspension and self-carriage.

The foreleg shows sufficient knee action but could have more reach.

The hindleg bends adequately but should be placed more powerfully underneath.

Conformation:

Pavarotti is a well-developed, harness-typed stallion standing correctly in the rectangular model, with clear stallion expression. The head is expressive but could be more refined in shape. The neck has good length, although the poll-to-neck connection could be lighter. The neck has good length, plenty of crest, emerges deep from the chest, is well-muscled, and well set on. The withers are well developed and of good length. The shoulder is well positioned and of good length. The back is of good length and musculature but slightly dipped. The loins are well muscled and connected. The croup is sloping, sufficiently long, and notably well muscled. The thigh is long. The foreleg is correctly aligned both from the side and from the front. The hindleg is correctly set. The pasterns are of good length, though slightly upright behind. The foundation is well developed and of good quality. The hooves are well shaped and of good quality, with healthy heels.

Pedigree:

The black stallion Pavarotti, who has already been active in sport for several years, is sired by the proven KWPN breeding stallion Bocellie, a large Hackney stallion by the keur-licensed Plain's Liberator, and out of the studbook mare Emely W (s.Manno pref). Dam Emely W has produced four foals. Her dam line has yielded many successful international driving and show horses through granddam, great-granddam, and great-great-granddam. Older, well-known horses from this line include Karel (s.Fortissimo, 196 competition points) and Tyroon (s.Fabricius, 227 competition points). More recent performers include Irene (keur pref sport by Bayard, 109 competition points), her daughter Edelroos (elite pref sport-harness PROK by Vaandrager HBC, 135 competition points), and most recently the four-year-old Ruby Roos (keur, IBOP 76.5/79). Pavarotti is the fifth KWPN-approved son of Bocellie.

Performance test report:

Pavarotti is an honest, very reliable harness-typed stallion with a functional disposition. He shows a strong willingness to work and is very pleasant to handle under saddle. The walk is active and shows good ground cover. In harness, the stallion displays sufficient to ample front and good body posture, though his ear expression could be slightly more attentive. Pavarotti demonstrates high knee action and good reach in the foreleg. The hindleg bends well and is sufficiently powerful, though it could step slightly more closed underneath the body. The stallion shows much suspension, rhythm, and balance. He possesses great enthusiasm for work and gives his driver a good feeling. During the test, Pavarotti stood out for his consistency and his ability to relax easily after exertion.

Stable behavior:

Honest, reliable stallion, remarkably easy to handle, and calm in the stable.

Veterinary report:

No abnormalities observed.

Semen Evaluation:

Expected fertility class: satisfactory.

Breeding/ Mating advice:

Pavarotti can improve front, suspension, and rhythm and balance. Mares should preferably have good body posture.

Dam report:

Emely W is a generously developed, harness-typed mare with a classical appearance, standing well in the rectangular model.

The head is sufficiently expressive.

The neck could be longer, with a lighter poll-to-neck connection.

The neck shows a slight underneck, is of good length and musculature, and is well set on.

The withers are well developed and sufficiently long.

The shoulder is of good length but could be more sloping.

The back is well proportioned and muscled.

The loins are well muscled and connected.

The croup is slightly sloping, sufficiently long, and well muscled.

The thigh is of good length.

The foreleg is correct when viewed from the front and slightly over at the knee when viewed from the side.

The hindleg is correctly set.

The pasterns are sufficiently long and slightly upright.

The hooves are well developed and of good quality with high heels.

The foundation is substantial and of good quality.

The walk is notably good, showing excellent scope, impulsion, and power.

In trot, the mare displays an appealing front, sufficient self-carriage, and much suspension.

The foreleg shows sufficient knee action and reach.

The hindleg bends well and steps powerfully underneath.

Emely W remains in good overall condition for her age.

Conformation:

Palladium is a sufficiently developed, harness-typed stallion standing adequately in the rectangular model, displaying youth and expression. The head is expressive. The neck has good length with a correct poll-to-neck connection. The neck has sufficient length, is well-muscled, crested, with a slight underneck, and is well set on. The withers are well developed and of good length. The shoulder has good length but could be slightly more sloping. The back is of good length and musculature. The loins are sufficiently muscled and well connected. The croup is slightly straight but of adequate length. The thigh is sufficiently long. The foreleg is correctly aligned both in front and from the side. The hindleg is correctly set. The pasterns, both front and hind, are of good length and correctly positioned. The foundation is well developed and of good quality. The hooves are moderate in quality, uneven in shape, with slightly underrun heels.

Pedigree:

The chestnut Palladium is a son of Hubert VDM (s.Cizandro) and the elite mare Inita M (s.Patijn). Hubert VDM descends from the highly successful Veldine line of Piet Lelieveld, which has produced not only four approved stallions but also many outstanding show and inspection horses, as well as numerous international driving horses. Hubert VDM is a half-brother of the late multiple champion and keur stallion Eebert (s.Atleet). Hubert VDM achieved 195 competition points (winstpunten) and multiple championships. He has been exported to the United States, where he also stands at stud. The dam line also carries a strong performance background. Dam Inita M comes from the renowned breeding line of Joop van Wessel and earned 26 competition points herself. She is out of the ster mare Tunita (s.Milano) and has produced three foals. The Van Wessel line continues to produce many successful performance horses and approved stallions. A notable example is the legendary elite, preferent, and multiple Grand Prix mare Taunita (s.Manno). Palladium is the first approved son of Hubert VDM.

Performance test report:

Palladium is an honest, reliable, and sensitive harness-type stallion with an excellent attitude. He shows much to very much willingness to work and is easy to handle under saddle. The walk is active and has good ground cover. In harness, the stallion displays an appealing front and very good posture. Palladium shows very good knee action and freedom in the foreleg. The hindleg bends well and is powerfully placed underneath. He demonstrates much to very much suspension, technique, and generally sufficient rhythm and balance. Palladium possesses much to very much desire to go forward. As a harness horse, he has a great deal of natural talent and gives his driver a good feeling. The stallion does not need speed to achieve self-carriage and made clear progress during the test.

Stable behavior:

Honest and reliable stallion, playful in character, generally calm in the stable.

Veterinary report:

No abnormalities observed.

Semen evaluation:

Expected fertility class: Satisfactory.

Breeding/ Mating advice:

Palladium can improve the desired harness-type movement. Mares should preferably have sufficient size and good-quality hooves.

Dam report:

Inita M is a sufficiently developed, harness-typed mare standing adequately in the rectangular model.

The head is expressive.

The neck has sufficient length and a correct poll-to-neck connection.

The neck is well shaped and muscled, long, and well set on.

The withers are well developed and sufficiently long.

The shoulder is of good length but could be more sloping.

The back is of good length and musculature, slightly dipped.

The loins are well muscled and connected.

The croup is slightly sloping, sufficiently long, and well muscled. The thigh is of good length.

The foreleg is correct when viewed from the front, slightly camped under when viewed from the side, and could be somewhat longer.

The hindleg is rather straight.

The pasterns are of sufficient length and well aligned.

The hooves are normally developed and of good quality, though slightly underrun at the heels.

The foundation is well developed and of good quality.

The walk shows good scope, impulsion, and power.

In trot, the mare displays an attractive front, sufficient self-carriage, and much suspension.

The foreleg shows sufficient knee action and good reach.

The hindleg bends well and is powerfully placed underneath.
